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### **CCA Policy Guidelines**

- **Compulsory** for every student to participate in at least **one** school-based CCA.
- Students may request for a **2<sup>nd</sup> CCA** through SH/PE&CCA only at the end of Sec 1 and when they have shown that they are able to cope well with both studies and CCA.
- Participation in outside activities in lieu of school CCAs will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Points will be awarded only if the activities are approved by the school.

### CCA Policy Guidelines

#### Change of CCA

Students can request for a change under the following conditions:

- on medical reasons or
- only **once at the end** of Secondary 1 or 2 with good reasons, justification and availability in CCA of choice.

Students in Uniformed groups are encouraged to stay in their CCAs through their four years


### Bidding Example 1

### Important Points to Note

- Shortlisted students on the importance of CCA bidding
- Time stamp of CCA bids is not important
- Estimated number of CCA vacancies as been made known to the students
- There will be a **5th compulsory CCA choice** of: Concert Band, NPCC, NCDCC or Scouts where the student may be allocated this CCA if he/she is not given either one of his/her 4 choices.
- Sec 1 students will attend the allocated CCA till end of Term 1 (trial period). A request for change will be considered on a case-by-case basis with valid reasons.


