5. Blended Learning (BL) Days in Term 3 (for Sec 1 to 3 students only)

Our Blended Learning Days in Terms 1 and 2 have been largely scheduled to take place on even-week Fridays every fortnightly. In Term 3 this year, our BL days will take place on selected days (4 July, 13 July and 26 July) for Sec 1 to 3 students. This takes into consideration the opportunities for different subjects to take on the approach of blended learning, and the availability of teachers due to their oral and invigilation duties for the national examinations, etc. Blended learning is a valuable component to in-person schooling. It allows students time and space to take responsibility for their own learning, practise effective time management skills, and explore areas of interests.

6. Mother Tongue Language Intensive Programme

The GCE 'O' Level MTL and MTL 'B' Exam will be conducted on Monday, 29 May and Tuesday 30 May respectively. The MTL Department will be conducting the MTL Intensive Programme for Sec 4 Express, Sec 5 Normal (Academic) and Sec 4 Normal (Academic) Out-of-Stream Students from 22 to 25 May during curriculum time.

7. Partnership with Parents (Meet the Parents Session on 26 May)

Parents are our key stakeholders and the school adopts various approaches to parent engagement. We would like to thank the parents who had attended the virtual Parents Engagement Session on Friday, 31 March. We would also like to invite parents to meet your child's Form Teachers on **Friday**, **26 May** between **8am to 12.30pm** for a discussion on your child's holistic development and progress in Semester 1. We are deeply appreciative of our Parent Support Group (PSG) and parents who have volunteered their time to serve as CCA chaperons as well as to participate actively in school activities. Your involvement role models your care towards your child's education and the responsibility you uphold as a concerned citizen. We have started conversations with our PSG to raise awareness of the mental wellbeing of our students, and we hope more parents can come on board to have deeper discussions on how parents can better support your child, both mentally and academically.

To safeguard our teachers' wellbeing, we would also like to remind parents that teachers are not required to share their personal handphone numbers with parents, and they are not required to answer parents' queries after working hours. Parents can call the General Office during working hours to make an appointment with the teacher or leave a message for the teacher to return your call if you wish to have a conversation with our teachers. Mutual respect goes a long way in building a trusting home-school partnership that will benefit the holistic development of our students at Yuan Ching.

8. Holiday Programmes and Holiday Assignments (Jun)

To help students to close their learning gaps, there will be bridging programmes for Sec 1 Subject-Based-Banding (SBB) students from 29 May to 1 June, as well as remedial classes for selected Sec 1-5 students from 29 May to 1 June and 19 to 20 June. Some CCAs will have their CCA session between 31 May to 1 June and 19 to 23 June. Students involved in bridging programmes, remedial classes or CCA will be notified by their teachers. Holiday assignments will be given to the students. We seek parents' support to encourage your child to plan his/her time well so that he/she can have a well-deserved break and meaningful holiday.
