1. Principal's Address

Thank you dear parents for working with the school to bring about an enriching Term 3 for our students and staff. With your trust and support, we have successfully commemorated our nation's 58th National Day. As part of the larger community celebration, our Scouts CCA formed a contingent as part of West Area Scouts engagement with the public at Yuhua Community National Day Observance Ceremony on 9 August while 6 of our students from NCDCC and Scouts participated as members of the marching contingents at the National Day Parade at the Padang.

Students and staff continue to contribute back to the community as they participated in Homerun event by Taman Jurong CC Zone B Youth Chapter on 16 August. The sports leaders participated as road marshals, helped out at carnival booths and job shadowed the committee members while the rest completed a 7km run as part of the effort to contribute to the sponsorship for needy families in the community. On the academic front, a team of 4 students represented the school and Singapore at the 56th Joint School Science Exhibition in Hong Kong from 21 to 28 August, to showcase their STEM project of a Net-Zero Vertical Garden through harnessing renewable sources of energy.

In the area of physical sports, our Dragon Boat CCA made waves at the Pesta Sukan competition on 29 July and were commended by the organiser and audience for their grit and determination as they pitted their skills against more experienced teams in the open category. Equally mind-blowing was our Dragon and Lion Dance teams, who won the Gold awards in both the youth and female categories at the 27th Ngee Ann City National Lion Dance championship 2023! As part of school's effort imbuing and embracing inclusivity, our students have been training with Grace Orchard School for the football match under Play Inclusive 2023 on 16 September. So do come down to support our students!

We are heartened to see our students expressing their appreciation for their teachers through the Student-Teacher Games and Teacher's Day Carnival, leading up to the class celebrations on 31 August. We are also grateful to the Parents Support Group (PSG) and School Advisory Committee (SAC) for joining us at the Staff Appreciation Dinner held on 25 August. We hope that our students have been positively influenced by your role-modelling to show gratitude, acts of kindness and be gracious to the people around them.

We are thankful for the strong partnerships that create opportunities for our students to experience the culture of care in the school. Our PSG has dedicated a lot of effort in supporting our students during their CCAs as adult chaperones, motivating our students in the weekly CLIMB programme and encouraging our graduating students through the Evening Self-Study.

5. END-OF-YEAR ACADEMIC MATTERS

5.1 Sec One to Three End-of-Year Examination (27 Sep to 9 Oct)

The End-of-Year Examination will be conducted from 27 September (Wed) to 9 October (Mon). Your keen interest in your child's preparation for the examination will motivate him/her to do well. A copy of the examination timetable was given to your child on 25 August. It will also be made available on the school website. We hope that you will monitor your child's preparation for the examination.

This examination is a critical milestone especially for the Sec 2 students as it will impact their decisions on the options for the subjects that they would like to pursue at the upper secondary level.

5.2 Subject Combination Option Exercise for Sec 3, 2024

Information and timeline on the Sec 3 Subject Combinations for 2024 will be given to all Sec 2 students at the start of Term 4. We hope that you will go through the subject combination with your child to guide him/her in his/her choice. Students are expected to exercise their options via MOE Forms by the stipulated deadline.

Our teachers will be serving as invigilators for the GCE 'O' Level Examination written papers which starts on 19 October (Thu). All Sec 1 to 3 students will be dismissed at 12.10pm on 19 October (Thu).

In order to create a conducive environment for our Sec 4N students for their GCE 'N' Listening Comprehension Examinations, students will be dismissed earlier on the following dates:

12 September - Sec 1 & 2 students will be dismissed at 1.20pm while Sec 3 students will be dismissed at 1.55pm.

5.5 Last Day of School for Sec 1 to 3 Students (27 Oct)

As our school is a GCE 'O' Level Examination centre, the last day of the school term is 27 October (Fri). On that day, we will release the Report Books and Textbook List for 2024.

All students will be dismissed at 10.30am on that day. Form teachers will then meet up with the parents of selected students to give feedback on the students' learning progress. We hope that you will take note of the date as your presence will be critical in ensuring that your child is well prepared for study the following year.

5.6 Student Council Training Camp and Preparation for 2024 Sec 1 Orientation (19 Dec to 20 Dec)

The Student Council Training Camp will be from 19 to 20 December (Tue to Wed). The camp is a key training programme for the leadership development of Student Councillors. It is also a platform for the Student Council to prepare for the upcoming Sec 1 Orientation Programme. All Student Councillors are expected to participate in the training camp.

6. 2023 NATIONAL EXAMINATIONS

We would like to highlight that the GCE 'N' Level Written, Listening Comprehension and Practical Examinations will be held from 12 to 21 September and from 2 to 10 October.

We would also like to highlight the start dates of the GCE 'O' Level Examination for your attention:

25 September - GCE 'O' Level Mother Tongue 'B' Oral Examination
4, 9, 12 & 17 October - GCE 'O' Level Science Practical Examinations
18 October - GCE 'O' Level Mother Tongue 'B' and English Language LC
19 October - GCE 'O' Level Written Examinations

Lessons will resume from 21 to 29 September for all Sec 4NA students and from 22 to 29 September for all Sec 4NT students. We hope that you will take note of the dates of the examination and support your child in his/ her preparation. Your child may stay home to revise on days that he/she is not offered the subjects examined.

The Sec 4N students are not required to report to school after the completion of the GCE 'N' Level Examination on 10 October. The tentative date for the release of the GCE 'N' Level results is mid-December 2023.

7. ACADEMIC SUPPORT FOR GRADUATING CLASSES

7.1 Evening Self-Study

To allow students to have a conducive environment for self-revision, the school has extended its closing hour till 8.30 pm during the week 21 August (Mon) to 24 August (Thu). The next block week identified for evening self-study is from 25 September (Mon) to 28 September (Thu).

The classrooms will be opened for students to conduct self-study. Parents of graduating students should have already received a notification letter via Parents' Gateway indicating the schedules of these sessions.

7.2 Home Study

To allow time for focused revision, home study for Sec 4E and Sec 5NA students will start from 2 October (Mon). Subject teachers may arrange for small group consultation sessions for those who need help in preparing for the GCE 'O' Level Examination.

8. STUDENT SAFETY & WELL-BEING

8.1 School Holiday Travel Plans

Students are advised to abide by MOH's travel advisory. You may have plans to travel overseas with your child during the year-end school vacation and we request that you provide details of your travel plans through the Parents Gateway (PG) app [Services>Declare Travels]. 8.2 School Safety

If your child is coming for school activities during the school vacation, please ensure that your child is well and not to come to school when feeling unwell. Students attending school activities, consultation sessions and/or the evening self-study should be attired in either full school uniform or half uniform (PE or CCA T-shirt and school skirt/pants) and put on proper footwear (school shoes or track shoes). This is to facilitate implementation of measures to maintain safety of students in school.

8.3 School Canteen

The school canteen will be closed during the school vacation. However, selected stalls will continue operations to meet the needs of students taking the GCE 'O' Level Examination.

8.4 MOE Financial Assistance Scheme
